## 20 - Sunday: Bangkok to Prachuap Khiri Khan

12th Annual Bangkok to Hua Hin ride. Bangkok to Hua Hin, Thailand. Annual event that attracts more than 500 cyclists. One-day ride begins in Bangkok and finishes in the Prachuap coast city of Hua Hin. Distance: 180kms. Ride starts from the Youth Center adjacent to the Bangmod Campus of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (126 Pracha-Utid Road, Bangmod, Toongkru, Bangkok). Meet at or just prior to 7:00am for a 7:30am ride off time. Ride is expected to arrive in Hua Hin (at the 19 Rai area) at approximately 15:30 (3:30pm). The lead group of riders (50 in total), who will be wearing special jerseys in honor of His Majesty the King of Thailand, will maintain a 30-35km pace while the following group (400+ in total expected) will maintain a 25-30km pace. There is no cost to participate in this ride but riders are expected to pay for their own expenses along the way. The entire distance (180kms) will be separated into 4 sections, with 3 stopping points in between where riders will enjoy a 30 minute break. In previous years, a shuttle bus back to Bangkok was provided, but this year participants are responsible for their own transportation back to Bangkok from the finish point in Hua Hin.
